- 2. Bus Budget for MPPP (Mesa Prieta) trips. Taos Charter School (K thru 8<sup>th</sup> grades) is committed to Mesa Prieta curriculum. - 14. Statewide Conference in 2019: Taos venue considered, board leaning toward approval but tabled for final decision, if successful it would yield funds for TAS.
